The Christian Community Placement Center (CCPC) is looking for a stable home which can dedicate a single bedroom for the temporary placement of youth and children in crisis (ages 9-18). This home would be fully certified by CCPC and supported with regular training, 24/7 on-call support, and a qualified team of counselors and professionals. Though the number of placements would vary depending on referrals, a consistent and regular monthly stipend would be provided to the home.

Interested homes must have one dedicated bedroom for the program. Experience working with behaviorally challenged children or youth is preferred. Additional requirements include:

- At least 21 years of age
- Able to provide an emotionally and physically safe home
- Must demonstrate sound judgment and the ability to work with youth
- Possess a high level of self-awareness and interpersonal communication skills
- Able to become certified through CCPC's certification process
- Valid Oregon Driver's License and reliable vehicle with current insurance
- Personal liability insurance (homeowner/renter insurance)
- Able to pass a criminal history background check and fingerprinting
- Able to be First Aid/CPR Certified
- Experience with collaborative problem solving and motivational interviewing is desirable
- Bachelor's degree or three years' experience working with youth is preferred, but not mandatory
